- WHAT IS ROUND DANCE? ROUND DANCE IS THE CHOREOGRAPHED VERSION OF BALLROOM DANCING, WHERE PAIRS OF DANCERS DANCE IN UNISON TO THE DIRECTION OF A CUER. THE COUPLES TRAVEL IN A CIRCLE TO A WIDE VARIETY OF MUSIC AND RHYTHMS, INCLUDING WALTZ, TWO-STEP, FOXTROT, CHA-CHA, RUMBA, JIVE, AND OTHERS.
- WHY ROUND DANCE? DANCE CAN HELP US BE FIT PHYSICALLY, BUT THE ACCOMPANYING LEARNING OF CUES AND SOCIALIZING CAN ALSO SUPPORT BRAIN FITNESS. WHILE THERE ARE PRACTICAL REASONS TO CONSIDER TAKING UP ROUND DANCE, THE CHIEF MOTIVATION IS THE BEST ONE. ROUND DANCE IS FUN.
- WHAT DO YOU NEED TO LEARN ROUND DANCE? KNOWING ONE'S LEFT FROM ONE'S RIGHT IS UNDOUBTEDLY BENEFICIAL, BUT MORE IMPORTANTLY, THE NEW DANCER NEEDS TO COMMIT TO CONSISTENT ATTENDANCE AT WORKSHOPS. CUES BUILD ON EACH OTHER AND REPETITION HELPS WITH MUSCLE MEMORY. SOFT-SOLED SHOES ARE NECESSARY. A PARTNER IS PREFERRED, BUT EITHER GENDER CAN LEARN THE ROLE OF LEADER OR FOLLOWER.

Come to the initial workshops of the new semester. It is free and open to the public. See experienced dancers demonstrate various rhythms and start learning the steps for the waltz.

Subsequent workshops are \$8 for beginners and \$12 for experienced dancers.
